Feed our children and they will fuel our future

Family Day Care Homes can receive reimbursement for meals served to enrolled children ages 12 and under.

Eligible providers may be reimbursed for up to two meals and one snack, or two snacks and one meal, for each enrolled child per day.

To qualify for CACFP, family day care homes must be state licensed, residential certified or qualify for relative care or alternate approval.

July 2018-June 2019 Reimbursement Rates

	Tier I	Tier II
Breakfast	\$1.31	\$0.48
Snack	\$0.73	\$0.20
Lunch/ Supper	\$2.46	\$1.48

Providers receive reimbursement through Family Day Care Home Sponsoring Organizations. Your **sponsor** will provide initial training and annual training thereafter.

Tier 1 reimbursement may be received when:

- The provider is located in a low-income area.
- The provider's home is considered a low-income household.
- A child or children in care are from low-income households.

Your **sponsor** will determine which rate your home will receive.
